Facilities

Accommodation:

Suites:

The 'padipurra' usually contains one or two rooms for guests. . The two suites are designed like the traditional 'padipurra' with Teak wood doors and bronze bolts. The experience is complete with the wooden paneled interiors, lanterns and tradition teak wood cot.

The replicas of famous Ravi Verma paintings adorn the walls of the living room and the bedroom. Modern facilities like the fridge, televisions and modern bathrooms with bath tubs are also provided. Enjoy and experience all these at an affordable rate.

Tourist Destinations:

Vettikodode Temple: It is a famous snake temple where people believe by giving offerings their diseases will be cured. Hundred of people visit the temple during the annual festival.

Krishnapuram Palace: A classic example of Kerala style architecture, the Krishnapuram Palace was the residence of the erstwhile rulers of Kayamkulam. The palace is adorned with gabled roofs, narrow corridors and dormer windows - typical features of Kerala architecture. The age of the palace is unknown. A protected monument under the archaeology department, the palace gets its name from an ancient Krishna temple nearby.

Chettikulangara Temple: It famous for it's 'Kettukazcha festival' in the month of February/march. Huge colorful effigies of epic heroes are made by the villager out of locally available materials and offered to the Goddess.

Sasthamkotta: A beautiful tourist village Sasthamkotta the famous fresh water lake, surrounded by mountains on three sides, is safe and sound from the effects of modernization.

Parumala Church: The abode of the Indian Christian Saint Gregorios. Thousands of pilgrims without exception of age and gender come on foot from their homes on the death anniversary of the saint.

Matha Amrithanandamayi Ashram, Vallikavu: The dwelling place of Matha Amrithanandamayi Devi, is situated at Amrithapuri near Vallikavu. The Ashram is accessible both by road and boat.

Aranmulla Boat Race: Annual boat race is held here during the time of Onam in connection with the installation of the deity in nearby temple.

Sabarimala: The renowned shrine dedicated to Lord Ayyappa, is visited by cores of pilgrims every year. Pilgrims climb 18 sacred steps to be blessed by Lord Ayyappa.
